Challenge:

A UHD staff member requested support to source articles and books from a reference list for a job interview. The job interview was for a position as a tutor for a training course for a specialist group of physiotherapists. The reference list would help to prepare for the interview and if successful plan teaching the course.

Solution:

Library staff retrieved the full text and sent 74 articles and books within the week. This gave ample opportunity to prepare for the interview.

Immediate and future Impact:

"The immediate impact was a successful Job interview. A resource pack has also been made for my team from the reference list, helping them keep up to date with the latest evidence."

Success factors:

"The course I will be tutoring is up for a review in March and I will be suggesting some additional material to add into it – something I could not do without the awareness of all those articles and books that you all found for me."
